Program Objectives:

Most Frequently Asked Questions:

1. ***What happens next?*** Once registration is completed your son/daughter will be placed on a team.
2. ***What should my child wear to the practices and games?*** Tennis shoes or baseball cleats, T-shirt and shorts or sweat pants.
3. ***How many days and what day of the week do the practices and games take place?*** Two days per week; on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays or Saturdays.
4. ***What time do the practices and games take place?*** Saturdays between 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (1 hour each) and Weekdays at 6:00 & 7:00 p.m.
5. ***When will I find out what team my child is on?*** The coach of your child’s team will contact you about the first practice. If you haven’t heard from a coach by the week of **February 27th**, contact the Recreation Commission office at 706/883-1670.
6. ***How will my child be placed on a team?***
 - A) Parent/Coach expressed choice
 - B) School of Attendance
 - C) Staff Assignment
7. ***Who will be coaching my child? A volunteer!!*** The person coaching your child is **not** getting paid. If you or someone you know would be interested in volunteering please have them contact the Commission.
8. ***How long does the season last?*** **Practice Begins:** February 27th
Games: March 18th – May 26th
9. ***What will my child’s uniform consist of?*** Team Jersey, Pants & Cap
10. ***What equipment will my child need to participate?*** Glove, baseball cleats or tennis shoes
11. ***Where will the practices and games take place?*** George F. Harris Baseball Complex, Whitesville Rd. Elem. School (Front), Shuford Fields Softball Complex
12. ***Baseball Begins:*** March 18th, 2023 ***Picture Day:*** Saturday March 18th, 2023
