Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What should my child wear to the practices and games?

Tennis shoes or soccer cleats, T-shirt and shorts or sweatpants. Shin Guards are required for every practice and game.

2. *How many days and what day of the week do the practices and games take place?* Two days per week: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, or Saturdays. Days and times will vary week to week. Saturday practices will be between 9am to 1pm and weekday practices will be at 6:00 & 7:00 p.m. Practices can last up to an hour to an hour and a half. Games are just over an hour long.

3. When will I find out what team my child is on?

The coach of your child's team will contact you about the first practice. If you haven't heard from a coach by **<u>Tuesday February 21</u>**st, contact the Recreation Commission office at 706-883-1670.

4. How will my child be placed on a team?

Coaches and friends CANNOT be requested at this age level. Players will be placed on teams during the draft. Players can only request to be with siblings enrolled in the same age group. The only players pre-assigned to teams will be the coaches childrens.

5. Who will be coaching my child?

A volunteer!! The person coaching your child is <u>NOT</u> getting paid. If you or someone you know would be interested in volunteering please have them contact the Commission. Volunteer coaches are always needed and appreciated!
