Frequently Asked Questions:

- What should my child wear to the practices and games? Tennis shoes or soccer cleats, T-shirt and shorts or sweat pants. Shin Guards are recommended for every practice and game.
- 2. How many days and what day of the week do the practices and games take place? Two days per week: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays or Saturdays. Days and times will vary week to week. Saturday practices will be between 9 a.m. & 4 p.m. and weekday practices will be at 6:00 & 7:00 p.m. Both practices and games typically last about 45 minutes.
- 3. When will I find out what team my child is on? The coach of your child's team will contact you about the first practice. If you haven't heard from a coach by Monday February 22nd, contact the Recreation Commission office at 706/883-1670.
- 4. How will my child be placed on a team?
 - A) Parent/Coach expressed choice
 - B) School of Attendance
 - C) Staff Assignment to create even teams
- 5. **Who will be coaching my child?** A volunteer!! The person coaching your child is <u>not</u> getting paid. If you or someone you know would be interested in volunteering please have them contact the Commission. Volunteer coaches are always needed and appreciated!
