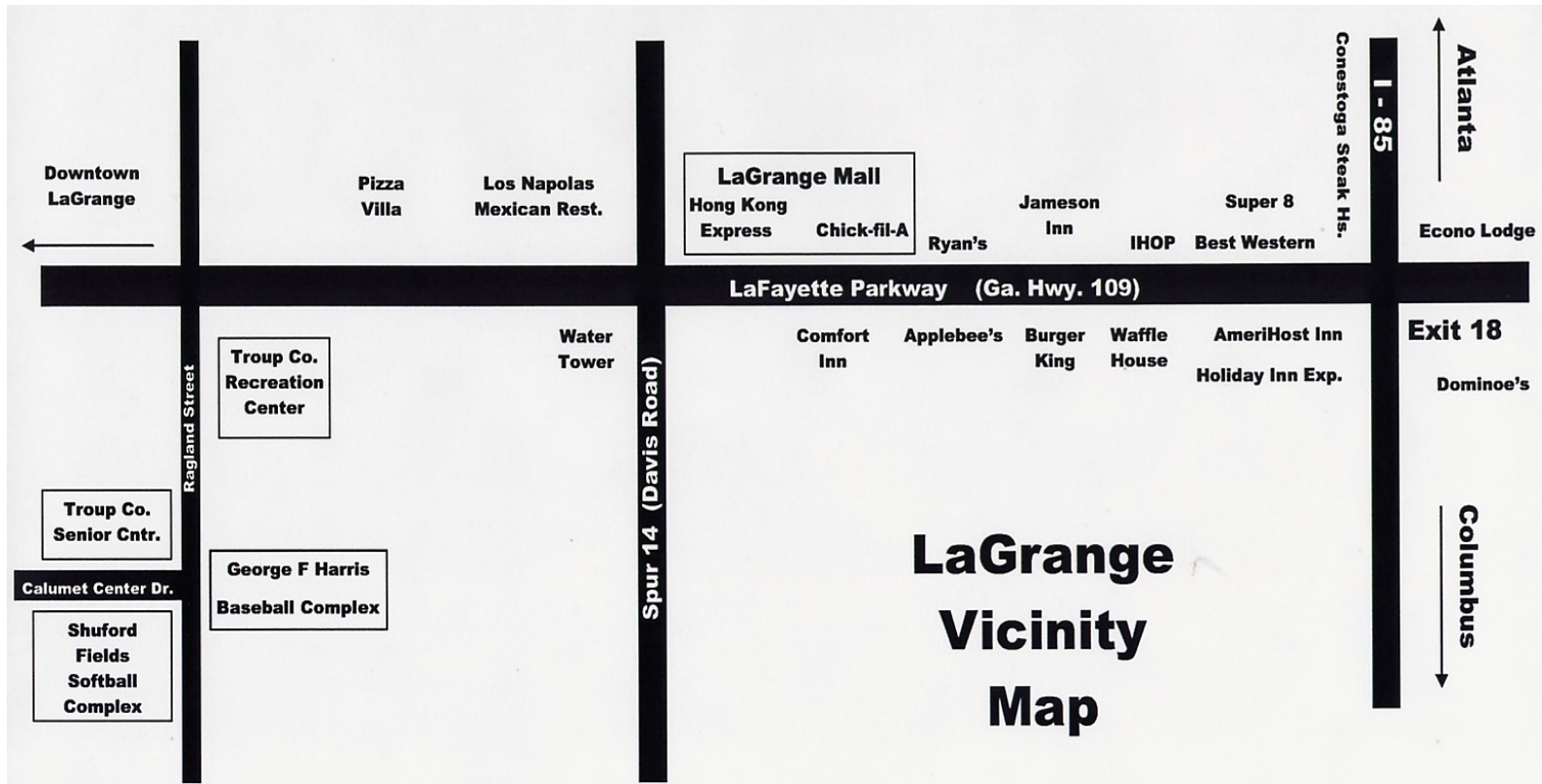

- LINE-UP CARDS:** Tournament officials will provide line-up cards for each team.
- INFIELD PRACTICE:** No infield practice will be permitted. Warm-up is allowed in designated areas only. Teams may warm-up in the outfield grass if time permits.
- BENCH AREAS:** 12 Players, 3 coaches, are the only individuals allowed in the bench area.
- PROTESTS:** The tournament protest committee will decide all protests. As manager, please be familiar with the rules of the game, including proper protest procedures.
- CONDUCT:** Managers and coaches are asked to have complete control of their players both on and off the field. Any report of damage by hotel management will be dealt with by the tournament officials.
- SOUVENIRS:** Souvenirs will be available throughout the week at the tournament site.
- FACILITY RULES:** **No pets, No Personal Coolers**, bicycles, skateboards, roller blades or motorized toys are allowed inside the tournament facility. The use of drugs and/or alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited. All litter must be placed in provided containers.
